HANS CHRISTIAN ANDERSEN - was born on April 2, 1805 in Odense, Denmark. He came from a poor family and attended the city's school for poor children. At 14, he left Odense, hoping to earn a living as an actor or singer in Copenhagen, the capital city. After three hard years of minor acting roles and barely enough to eat, he became friendly with a theatre director who raised money for him to continue his education.

Trained as singer and actor, and well known as a novelist and poet, Andersen's ultimate fame is based upon the collections of fairy tales he wrote between 1835 and 1872. Inspired by the Arabian Nights and the Brothers Grimm, he wrote 212 known fairy stories, only 12 of which were based on actual folk tales. Some were published in here America, even before being published in his native Denmark, and Hans Christian Andersen is now revered as the 'Father, of the modern fairy tale.
